Paul was born September 18th 1949 in Chicago and grew up in Los Angeles. He graduated at Westmount College in Santa Barbara with a BA in Economics and Business and obtained his Masters of Economics at Universitat Wien in Vienna, Austria. Paul was ahead of his time when it came to technology. He was an extremely insightful and visionary leader. He worked as a senior partner and director at Ernst and Young and did management consulting work for KPMG, Canada Health Infoway and many other companies. One of his proudest accomplishments was being the first CIO for the Government of Canada. Paul was selected as one of Canada's 30 top technology professionals, testified on 'Establishing a Federal CIO' for the U.S. Government, U.S. House of Representatives, was an advisor on Technology Policies for the U.S. Controller General and U.S. Congress and received a Lifetime Career Achievement in Technology. As a result of his career he also had the opportunity to travel around the world. Both professionally and personally Paul loved a challenge. He put his heart and soul into everything he set his mind to: from building a home from the ground up to making a tool to remove sticks from the bottom of a seadoo to fixing a computer glitch. He also loved the outdoors whether he was running up the Grouse Grind, kayaking on the Pacific Ocean, enjoying the fall colours at the cottage or sitting on a beach in Mexico.
